invasion this pioneering volume also offers the only history of the us tobacco monopoly in local agriculture and manufacture from its beginning in 1899 to the bankruptcy of its last successor company forty years later baldrich s extensive research documents the organization of the cigar and cigarette manufacturing sectors and the resulting development of trade unions and socialist ideals this multidisciplinary investigation gives due attention to the modifications that farmers made to tobacco planting and harvesting techniques in fine tuning plants to the expected aromas and tastes of the manufactured commodities in addition baldrich pays considerable attention to gender relations in the labor process not only in the manufacturing sector but also in tobacco agriculture the book also provides the only narrative of the rise and maturity of the hermanos cheos a powerful apocalyptical movement that began and spread in the tobacco growing regions ultimately this encompassing volume fills a major gap in the histories of tobacco producing islands in the caribbean

this book invites us to reflect on the restoration of terrestrial ecosystems in the context of a region whose identity is still under construction latin america and the caribbean immersed in a social economic ecological and political crisis whose roots originate historically and politically in colonialism and in the prevailing model of capital accumulation for the first time insights and practical experiences on restoration are gathered from most latin american and caribbean countries furthermore this book offers a social approach to restoration which will likely become preponderant in this field and in this region the authors claim that a latin american knowledge of restoration is under construction and that this discipline can be a significant tool to empower local populations which might in turn lead to a collective action of change case studies from 11 countries of the region were compiled involving multiple voices that emerge beyond generalist principles and with a bottom up approach the main idea of the book is to open a debate about the identity of ecological and social restoration in this region this book is targeted to restoration specialists volunteers environmental managers researchers politicians and ngos working on the complexity of socioecological restoration in a region with unavoidable social problems it is intended for people with similar concerns to those of the chapters authors this work tries to integrate a movement on the rise almost silent born with its own narratives of successes and failures that do not hinder its development finally the determination and commitment of latin american and caribbean social actors to restore not only natural values but also social ethical and cultural ones is remarkable

this collection focuses on the intellectual development of the sciences their relationships with technology and their place in culture in general including a proposed realignment of science technology and art

within and outside the legal and academic professions it is now increasingly recognised that the human rights consequences of states actions are not limited to the domestic sphere but quite often transcend national borders this is a challenge to the human rights community which up to the present time has focused almost exclusively on human rights violations and protections solely within a national setting the term extraterritorial effect application obligation in international law refers to acts that are taken by one actor state that have some kind of effect within another country s territory with or without this second country s implicit or explicit agreement extraterritoriality within international human rights law then concerns actions or omissions by one state that have an effect on the human rights of individuals in another state with or without this other state s agreement this effect may be positive or negative in that such actions or omissions by foreign states may contribute positively to the enjoyment of human rights or alternatively they may result in a deteriorated human rights situation and even human rights violations this book gives for the first time a comprehensive analysis of extraterritorial obligations in international human rights law by placing the discussion in a larger international law context interpreting obligations in the various sources of international human rights law and discussing the way in which extraterritoriality has been approached by international courts and human rights implementation bodies in the united nations and regional systems
